WHAT IS THE COMMUNITY RESPONSE FUND?

The COVID-19 crisis is hurting our community – but British Columbians come together to face challenges head-on. Right now that means making sure organizations that provide housing, food, and frontline services can do their essential work. It also means supporting the arts, culture, and other important community benefits.

With this in mind, Vancouver Foundation, Vancity Credit Union, United Way Lower Mainland and the City of Vancouver have teamed up to launch the Community Response Fund. Our goal is to provide a strategic response to this crisis that rapidly deploys essential relief to charities providing frontline services to those disproportionately impacted by the pandemic and its economic consequences, as well as those supporting arts, culture, and community benefit programs that are pillars within the community. Through the Fund, you can support all the vital services BC communities need to weather this storm.

KEY MESSAGES

1. The Community Response Fund is a collaborative fund launched by Vancouver Foundation, United Way Lower Mainland, City of Vancouver, and Vancity Credit Union to bring critical resources to local health and social services organizations that are working on the frontlines of the COVID-19 pandemic. In addition, this Fund now has a stream to support arts and culture charities, as well as community benefit programs.
2. Our goal is to provide a strategic response to this crisis that rapidly deploys essential relief to charities providing frontline services to those disproportionately impacted by the pandemic and its economic consequences. Its purpose is two-fold. First, to provide immediate relief to organizations in British Columbia who have been hit the hardest by COVID-19 and help them maintain their services and programs. Second, to support charities in the province to build long-term resilience within the community.
3. This is a community-inspired response to Covid-19; a partnership led by organizations from all sectors that have come together to leverage collective and complementary knowledge, expertise, and resources to direct resources to where they are needed most.
4. We know we're stronger together, which is why we're calling on both corporate and non-profit organizations, as well as individuals, to donate to this fund and extend a helping
