Who can Apply via Community Foundations of Canada?

The fund supports **qualified donees** in running projects at the community level that serve **vulnerable populations** that have been affected by COVID-19.

Qualified donees include:

- registered charities;
- registered Canadian amateur athletic associations;
- registered Canadian municipalities;
- registered municipal or public bodies performing a function of government in Canada.

Vulnerable groups amid COVID-19 include:

- Chinese communities;
- South Asian communities;
- Women and girls;
- Official languages minorities;
- Persons with disabilities.

*Non-profit organizations can apply via the Canadian Red Cross.
