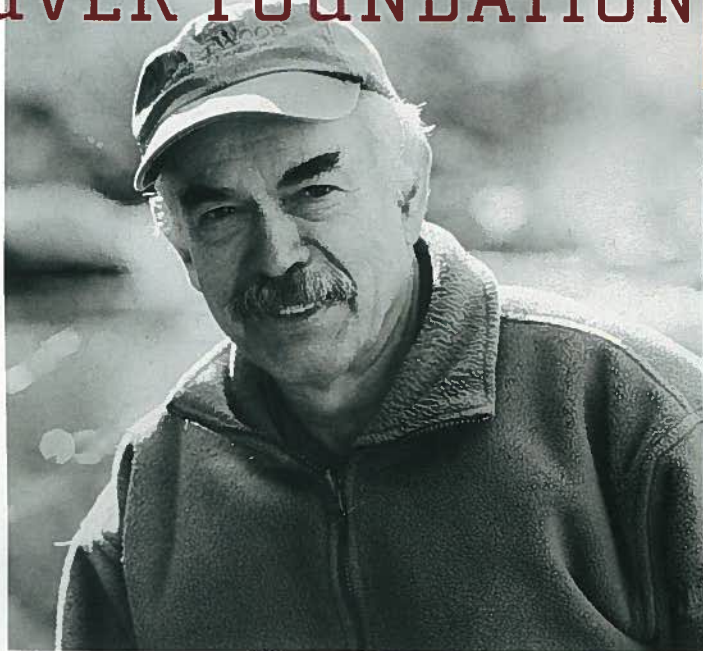




VANCOUVER FOUNDATION Annual Report 2000



A Catalyst for Strengthening Community

Sixty years ago, when Vancouver secretary Alice MacKay bequeathed \$1,000 to start an endowment fund dedicated to improving the quality of life in BC, W.J. VanDusen was inspired. The industrialist joined in her mission and convinced nine other business leaders to contribute \$10,000 each to seed a permanent endowment fund, from which the income would be used to fund projects at the Board's discretion. And so, from one person's vision, Vancouver Foundation was launched.

Visionary donors have since built the Foundation into **AN ENDOWMENT WITH CAPITAL OF ALMOST \$600 MILLION, SERVING AS THE CATALYST THAT HELPS MANY NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS ACROSS THE PROVINCE MEET COMMUNITY NEEDS.** Since inception, this growing capital has generated over \$400 million for projects from daycare to theatre, medical research to crisis centres. Governed by a volunteer board and advisory committees who review grant applications, the Foundation supports projects in seven fields of interest. You can read just a few examples of the projects we fund inside this annual report.

Trust is the hallmark of Canada's largest community foundation. Donors know they can rely on Vancouver Foundation to manage and steward their funds well. Agencies know we will respond to innovative ideas for projects that enhance life in our province. And communities in BC know that Vancouver Foundation can help them build capacity to pursue local opportunities.

2000 was a year of innovation and outreach for Vancouver Foundation. As well as providing 300 grants to not-for-profit groups across BC, we launched a pilot program to strengthen community foundations throughout the province. Through our regrants initiative, we provided \$250,000 to enable 23 community foundations to award grants in their communities from Revelstoke to Parksville and Prince George. We are also proud of our neighbour-

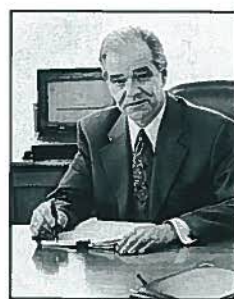
hood small grants program, which provides funds for grassroots projects that bring communities together. Another innovative project is our Youth Philanthropy Council, a model for the rest of the country. This enthusiastic group of 14-to-20-year-olds brings fresh ideas and new energy to the voluntary sector. There are now eight similar councils operating in BC communities.

An important part of Vancouver Foundation's mission is to provide philanthropic leadership to British Columbia. We accomplish this through a variety of unique initiatives. Our Partners in Organizational Development program helps non-profit groups strengthen their fundraising and management skills. Through our involvement in the Vancouver Arts Stabilization Fund, we enable arts organizations to enhance their business skills.

Vancouver Foundation is also a leader in philanthropy at the national level. Organizations across Canada look to us for assistance on strategies that strengthen communities and reduce dependence on government funding.

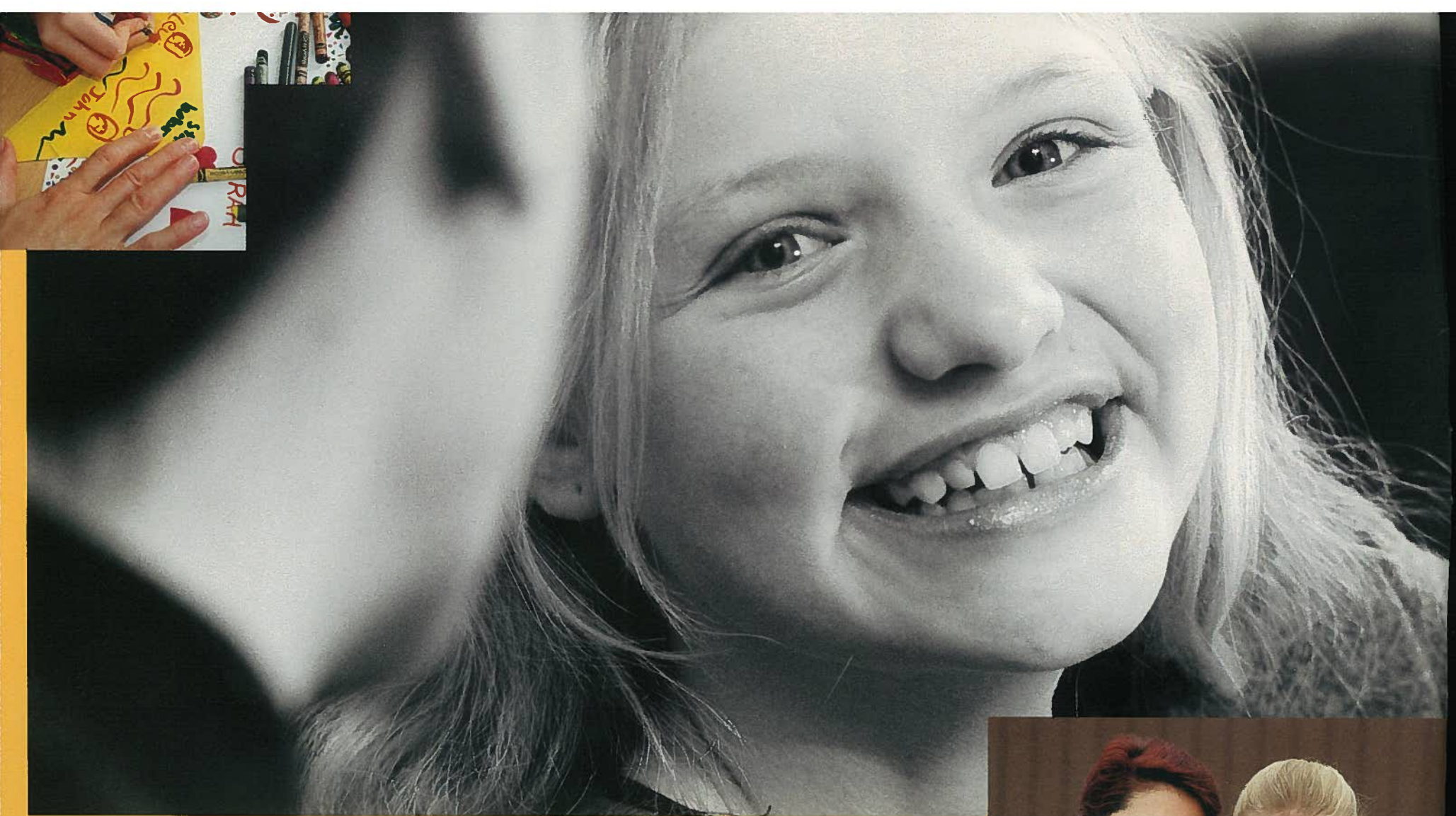

Providing Guidance

The Big Brothers and Sisters' in-school mentoring program gives kids the support they need to realize their potential



Lorraine Levitt knows first hand the satisfaction that comes with being an in-school mentor with Big Brothers and Sisters of Canada. “The other day the little girl I mentor came running out of the school in her stocking feet in the snow to greet me in the parking lot,” said Levitt. “It gave me such a great feeling.”

As the executive director of Big Brothers and Big Sisters in Williams Lake, Levitt wants as many people as possible to share such experiences. In 1998, she helped

start one of BC's first in-school mentoring programs with financial assistance from the George and Rae Poole Family Memorial Fund, administered by the Vancouver Foundation. Designed to help elementary school children who are having social or academic difficulties in school, the program matches kids with adult mentors who meet one hour a week on school grounds. They are free to do whatever they wish together: play games, surf the Internet or just go for a walk.

“The kids in the mentoring program are on the brink of success,” said Levitt.

“They just need a little encouragement from someone who wants to be there to help them with some of the hurdles they face.”

The pilot program was so successful at attracting volunteers and positively impacting children's lives that it grew from two schools and five matches *in 1998* to ten schools and over 30 matches last year. The in-school mentoring program is a model that has been widely adopted by Big Brothers and Big Sisters across Canada and has been supported by Vancouver Foundation in nine BC communities over the past five years.

Elaine Sager decided to become a mentor to 11-year-old Amanda S. three years ago, and has never looked back. “We’ve formed a really strong relationship,” said Sager. **“AMANDA HAS DEVELOPED SO MUCH MORE CONFIDENCE IN HERSELF. IT'S NICE TO BE A PART OF THAT.”**

Amanda says her friendship with Elaine has helped her become less shy and make more friends. “It's nice to hang out with someone who is older and you can talk to about things,” said Amanda. “Elaine understands me. It's fun.”

Braking Falls



More women die each year as a result of osteoporosis fractures than from breast and ovarian cancer combined. A new study might help prevent the falls that cause them



Mary Beth Trainer has broken her spine 11 times. Suffering from severe osteoporosis, she has lost much of the minerals in her skeletal system, leaving her bones porous and fragile. For years she lived with debilitating pain, rarely venturing outside her home.

"I was cranky and miserable," said Trainer. "I just sat on the couch watching TV. My way of life was hopeless."

For many, it's a familiar story. More than 1.4 million Canadians live with the symptoms of osteoporosis: chronic pain, spinal disfigurement, poor mobility and susceptibility to bone fractures caused by falling. There were nearly 20,000 osteoporosis-related hip fractures last year, 70% of which resulted in death or permanent disability.

To slow the onset of osteoporosis and reduce the likelihood of fractures, thousands of people participate in Osteofit classes in 55 communities across BC. Started in 1996 by the BC Women's and Children's Hospital, this community-based exercise program is designed to

improve the muscle strength, balance and quality of life for those with osteoporosis. Although anecdotal evidence suggests the program is working, no research has been done to prove its effectiveness.

Dr. Karim Khan and his research colleagues from the BC Women's Health Centre Osteoporosis Program are changing that. With the help of a grant from the BC Medical Services Foundation, administered by Vancouver Foundation, the UBC assistant professor

of Family Practice and Human Kinetics began a 20-week study last fall to objectively measure if Osteofit was achieving its stated goals. One hundred post-menopausal women aged 65-75 years were split into two groups and then measured for baseline strength, balance and level of life satisfaction. One group joined in Osteofit classes while the other participated in social activities. Both groups were then measured again after 10 and 20 weeks.

Dr. Khan is still analyzing the results, but the preliminary findings are encouraging. "There appears to be a significant improvement in balance and strength among the women who exercised in the Osteofit classes," he said. "THE WOMEN ALSO REPORTED THAT THE CLASSES IMPROVED THEIR FUNCTION AND CONFIDENCE, AND THAT THEY ENJOYED THE SOCIAL COMPONENT OF BEING WITH OTHER WOMEN WHO HAD SIMILAR PROBLEMS."

For Mary Beth Trainer, who participated in the study, life is worth living again. "The program got most of the pain out of my back," she said. "It's like having a constant toothache removed. The last few months have been wonderful. When I go for a walk now, it's actually enjoyable."

Rose Nakatsuru, Vancouver Foundation program director for the BC Medical Services Foundation advisory committee, says programs like the Osteofit study are chosen for funding by a panel of medical experts based on strict criteria. "Everything has to be in order—the methodology, sample populations, technical aspects and so on," she said. "In addition to meeting these requirements, the Osteofit study was selected because it dealt with a major health issue, responded to a community need and

would shed light on an area where there hasn't been a lot of research."

Dr. Khan is optimistic Vancouver Foundation's support will pay off. "The research findings will become part of the osteoporosis and fall prevention strategy for the province," he said. "They might also help modify the Osteofit exercises to achieve even better results."

A Child Shall Lead Them

The Youth Millennium Project encourages children to find local solutions to global problems

Two and a half years ago, Rebecca Slate and Justine Wiltshire sat around a campfire on Gabriola Island discussing the upcoming millennial New Year's Eve celebrations. The two UBC graduates felt that it was a historic opportunity to reflect on our progress as a world community and think of ways to improve our global society. While the rest of the world was preparing to party, they began planning what would eventually become the Youth Millennium Project.

"We decided to help raise awareness about global issues and help youth create a sense of self confidence in the face of pressing global challenges," said Slate. "Global issues can be overwhelming for anybody, but for youth specifically because they feel a special sense of powerlessness."

They started creating the Youth Millennium Project by conducting an elementary school survey which showed that young people felt they couldn't make a difference in the world because they were isolated and not taken seriously. Based on this research they designed brochures that invited youth to identify 10 important global issues and then carry out a plan of action that would help address one of them. The brochures were then translated into 65 languages and sent around the world through UNICEF offices.

The response was overwhelming. Young people from across the globe sent in thousands of photos, drawings and essays relating to the projects they were working on. Kids raised awareness of AIDS in Azerbaijan, planted trees in Namibia, helped youth get off the street in Columbia and sold chickens to buy school supplies

in Vietnam. Today, more than 8,000 young people in over 50 countries are involved in the Youth Millennium Project.

"We don't tell the kids what they should work on or care about – we ask them," said Slate. "I think that's really key to the success of the project."

When 13-year-old Madeline Pollard Hyde first heard about the Youth Millennium Project, she and three fellow students at Vancouver's General Wolfe elementary school knew they wanted to get involved. They discovered that a hospital in Guyana needed books on tape for blind children and decided to record C.S. Lewis' Chronicles of Narnia series.

"WE'RE GOING TO GROW UP AND EVENTUALLY BE THE ONES RUNNING THE WORLD SO IT'S IMPORTANT TO GET STARTED AT A YOUNG AGE TO GET A GOOD UNDERSTANDING OF THINGS," SAID MADELINE. "THE YOUNGER YOU ARE WHEN YOU GET INVOLVED IN GLOBAL ISSUES, THE MORE YOU CAN DO OVER YOUR LIFETIME."

To help build on the success of the Youth Millennium Project, the Robert and Florence Filberg Fund, administered by Vancouver Foundation provided funding last year to prepare for an evaluation of its impact around the world. Slate plans to survey and interview program participants, as well as review material the children sent in.

"We want to get a better grasp of what global issues kids really care about and find out the most positive and frustrating experiences they had in implementing their projects," said Slate. "Basically we want to increase our ability to help children shape positive social change."

Opening the Floodgates

Community groups across the province are working to improve the health of rivers affected by hydroelectric dams

A few years ago, Geoff Clayton looked upon the Alouette River with despair. The once vibrant waterway was now little more than a trickling stream meandering through the Ridge Meadows valley. The wild salmon, whose annual spawning runs are estimated to have numbered as high as 500,000 at the turn of the century, had been extinct for decades. And pollution from surrounding floodplain developments had raised dangerously high coliform counts in the summer months. "The river was slowly dying," said Clayton. "It was being strangled to death." While many factors were contributing to the river's poor condition – past riverbed dredging, leaching from nearby septic tanks, urban development – the main cause was the Alouette Dam. Built by the Burrard Power Company in 1925 to help supply the Lower Mainland's growing power needs, the dam reduced the river's downstream water flow from an average of 800 cubic feet per second to just two cubic feet per second—a reduction of well over 99%.



Determined to save the river, Clayton, a longtime resident of the area and a former BC Hydro power engineer, joined the Alouette River Management Society in 1994 to lobby for increasing the amount of water released below the dam. In 1996, ARMS was invited to participate in a pilot project that brought BC Hydro and community groups together to see how the health of the river could be improved. After nine months of research and negotiation an agreement was reached and water flow was increased to an average of 92 cubic feet per second.

The results have been dramatic. "People enjoy coming to the river again," said Clayton, now president of ARMS. **"FOR THE FIRST TIME SINCE THE 1920S WE'VE HAD CHINOOK BACK SPAWNING. THE ALOUETTE'S EVEN BEEN DESIGNATED A BC HERITAGE RIVER."**

Clayton credits ecologist Dr. Craig Orr for support and encouragement during the negotiations with BC Hydro. He provided ARMS with the scientific data and technical knowledge necessary to effectively make its case to the power company's officials.

In 1998, Orr became the executive director of the Watershed Watch Salmon Society, an organization funded by the VanDusen Foundation, administered by Vancouver Foundation, which is dedicated to helping community groups participate in water-use planning. Since then, Watershed Watch has been working with dozens of community groups like ARMS on a five-year planning process that will review water-use issues at all 30 BC Hydro dams throughout the province.

"We're solution oriented," said Orr. "We believe it's important for NGOs and abo-

original groups to be involved in the planning process stage and actually put some deliverables on the table."

Mauro Vescera, Vancouver Foundation program director for the environment advisory committee, says Watershed Watch's collaborative, constructive approach to solving water-use issues made it an ideal candidate for funding. "We believe that solutions to pressing environmental concerns can only be found if we involve local constituencies in the decision-making process," he said. "Community members need to be brought to the table."

Geoff Clayton couldn't agree more. **"OUR EXPERIENCE HAS GIVEN GREAT HEART TO THE COMMUNITY,"** he said. "It's a wonderful feeling knowing that our passion and dedication helped save the Alouette."

Neighbouring on Success

An innovative small grants program is bringing inner-city communities together

A haunted house might not seem like the ideal vehicle to bring a community closer together. Especially one with a cemetery out front and a 'horror' room inside containing dismembered body parts.

But 18-year-old Chris Mulvena's haunted house was different. He built the 20-foot high structure with four high school friends to provide residents of Hastings-Sunrise, an inner-city neighbourhood in Vancouver's east side, with some free Halloween entertainment. Dozens of families and children from nearby elementary schools visited the haunted house, which was on display for two days last October at the Frog Hollow Neighbourhood House.

Mulvena greeted each of them dressed as an alien. "I GOT TO TALK TO A LOT OF PEOPLE FROM THE COMMUNITY WHO I PROBABLY WOULDN'T HAVE MET OTHERWISE," he said. "I really had a good time."

The haunted house was just one of 36 projects undertaken in 2000 as part of the Neighbourhood Small Grants project with funding from the VanDusen Foundation, and the Stewart Fund, administered by Vancouver Foundation. Designed to build stronger, healthier communities in Vancouver's Hastings, Renfrew, Kensington and

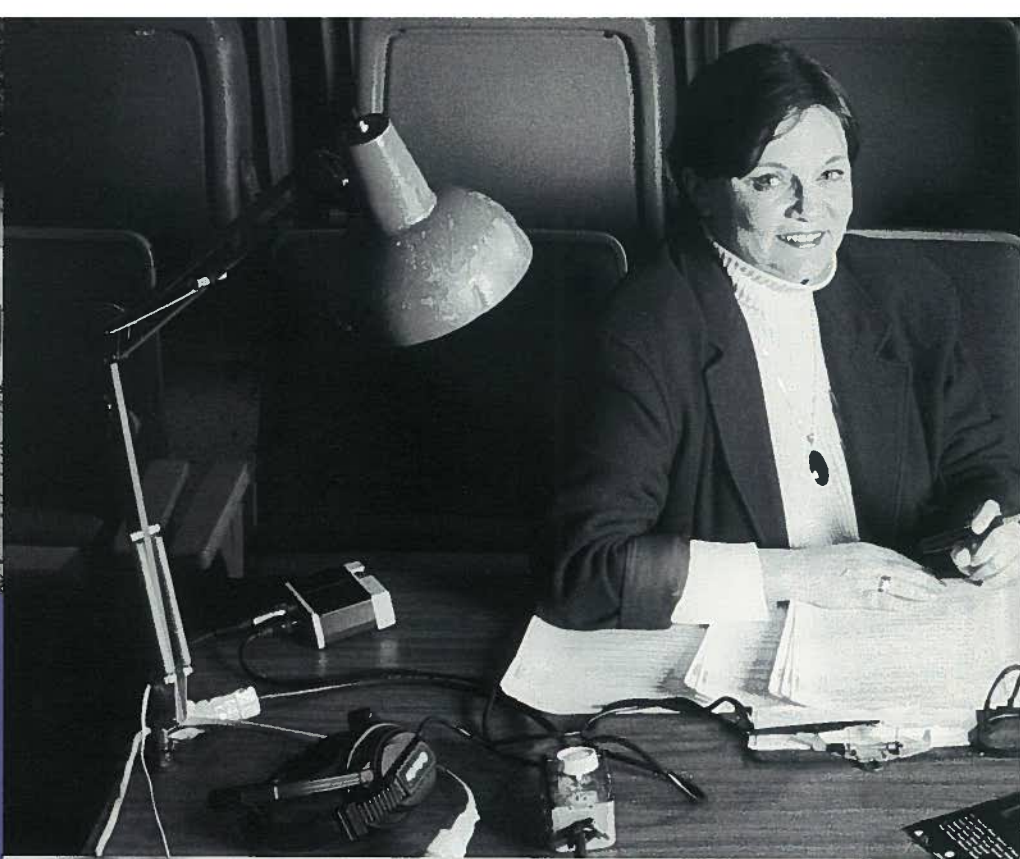

to implement projects that benefited their community physically, socially or culturally. The program is a partnership between three neighbourhood houses: Kiwassa, Cedar Cottage and Frog Hollow. Projects ranged from potluck dinners and community gardens to fence repairs and a lantern parade.

According to Donna Chang, who as executive director of the Cedar Cottage Neighbourhood House helped disburse the grants with a local residents' committee, the program is modelled on the principles of "asset-based" community development, which focuses on the strengths rather than the problems of a particular neighbourhood. "All our residents have skills and expertise," she said. "By utilizing these capabilities with programs like the small grants initiative, we help residents work together to overcome the challenges the community faces."

Chang says the program has been a huge success so far. "People keep telling me how much fun they're having," she said. "A real sense of opportunity and belief in self has been created."

The Servants Anonymous Society helps young women leave the life of prostitution behind

Shelley D. clearly remembers the day she hit rock bottom. Addicted to cocaine, she was working as a prostitute to pay for drugs and obliterate her feelings of resentment and inadequacy. Her relationship with her husband was in tatters. And her three young children had been apprehended by the BC Ministry for Children and Families. Unable to cope, she suffered a mental collapse two years ago and was admitted to the psychiatric ward at Kelowna General Hospital.

"I just fell apart," said Shelley. "My life was totally unmanageable. I desperately wanted to clean up, especially for my children."

For many years, Gilbert Paul Jordan preyed on women in Vancouver's Downtown Eastside. He would prowel skid row bars looking for middle-aged women lonely and desperate enough to accept an invitation back to his apartment or barber shop. Once there, he would force them to drink themselves to death. Jordan was eventually convicted on one count of first-degree murder in 1987, but he is suspected to be responsible for a number of additional deaths.

When Marie Clements read about the murders of the women, many of whom were Aboriginal, in The Vancouver Sun, she felt compelled to write about them. "So much of the article in the paper was about him and very little had to do with the women he killed," said the Metis playwright. **"THESE WOMEN HAD LIVES AND DREAMS AND PEOPLE WHO LOVED THEM. THEIR STORIES HAD BEEN SILENCED FOR TOO LONG."**

So Clements penned The Unnatural and Accidental Women, a play about a young Aboriginal woman who uncovers the stories of 10 people killed by Jordan before discovering that her mother was also a victim.

With the help of a grant from the Robert and Florence Filberg Fund, administered by Vancouver Foundation, the play was produced last fall by the Firehall Arts Centre, located mere yards from where some of the murders took place. The theatre's mandate is to present socially and politically relevant theatre that is reflective of the cultural diversity of Canada. It was an ambitious project that added previously unheard voices to Vancouver's theatre scene and provided many Aboriginal women a first-time opportunity to be involved in the production of a play.

"We felt it was important to produce this work as it allowed audiences to understand and view Jordan's victims as individuals, not statistics," said Donna Spencer, who as artistic producer of the Firehall Arts Centre co-directed the play. "It also brought greater attention to some of the problems and challenges faced by individuals living in the neighbourhood surrounding Firehall."

In conjunction with the play, the Firehall ran a theatre apprenticeship program and a writers' workshop for women living in the community. These initiatives allowed local residents to explore career options in the performing arts and gave them an opportunity to share their life stories in poetry and prose.

"It was an amazing experience for the women who got involved," said Spencer. **"THEIR SELF-CONFIDENCE GREW FROM THE POINT OF BEING INTIMIDATED BY ENTERING THE THEATRE, TO FEELING LIKE THEY BELONGED AND THAT THEIR VOICES MATTERED."**

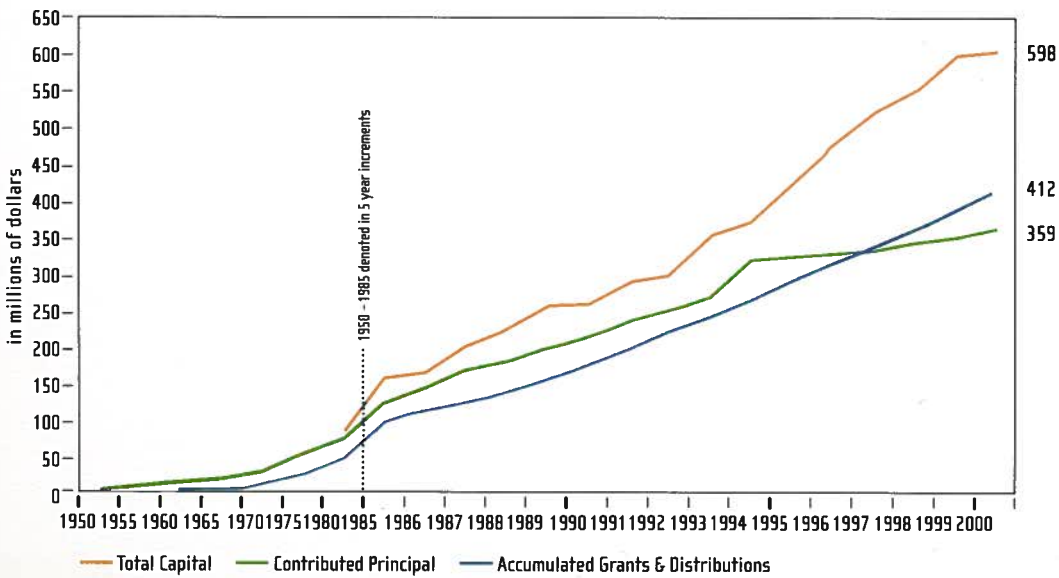

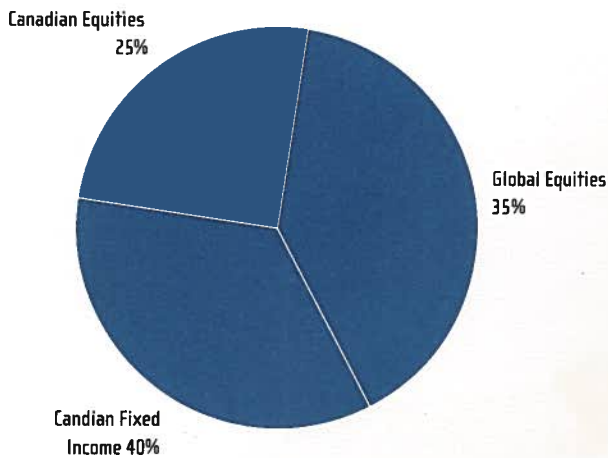

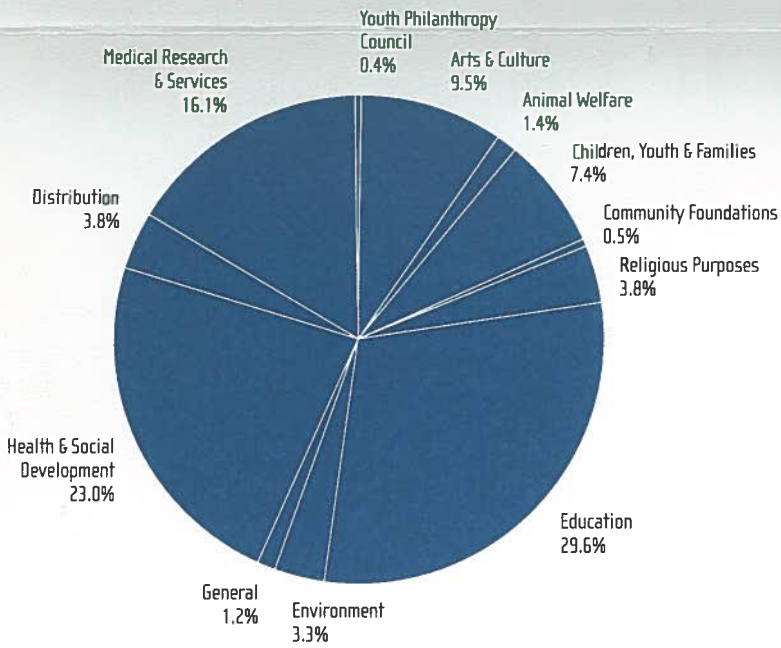
CAPITAL GROWTH



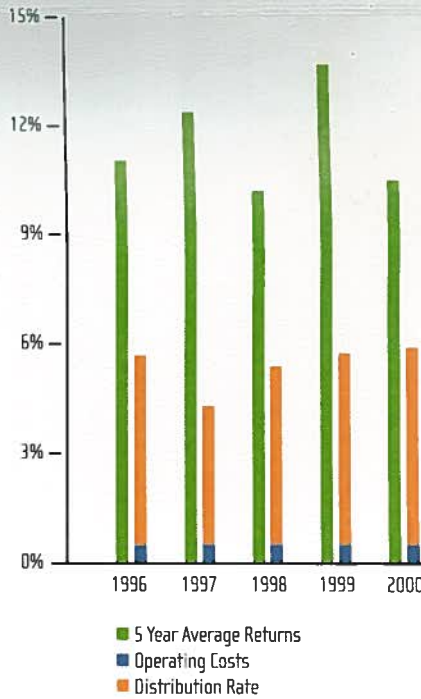
INVESTMENT STRUCTURE

AUDITORS' REPORT

To the Directors of Vancouver Foundation

We have audited the statements of financial position of Vancouver Foundation as at December 31, 2000 and 1999 and the statements of changes in consolidated trust fund and funds' income for the years then ended. NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS
December 31, 2000 and 1999

1 Purpose and status

Vancouver Foundation (the "Foundation") was established in 1943 and became incorporated through an Act of the Provincial Legislature in 1950.

The income from funds donated and bequeathed to its endowment is used to provide for charitable purposes throughout British Columbia. The Foundation serves three major constituencies: its donors, the charitable sector and the community.

The Foundation is registered with the Charities Division, Canada Customs and Revenue Agency and is classified as a public foundation. As such, it is exempt from federal income taxes and can issue charitable donation receipts.

2 Consolidated and Other Trust Funds

The Consolidated Trust Fund comprises those assets over which the Foundation exercises discretionary investment control within guidelines established by the Board of Directors. The Other Trust Funds comprise those assets over which the Foundation does not exercise discretionary investment control and which are administered in accordance with specific directions from the donors.

3 Accounting policies

The following accounting policies used by the Foundation are stated below to assist in understanding the financial statements.

Bequests and grants

Bequests are recorded upon receipt of the donated assets. Bequests in a form other than cash or marketable securities are recorded at values determined by the Board of Directors. Grants are recorded when paid by the Foundation.

Investments

Investments within the Consolidated Trust Fund are valued at current market prices on the last business day of the fiscal period. Investments within the Other Trust Funds are stated at cost and any realized gains or losses arising from investment transactions are included as part of contributed principal. Should the carrying value of the investments exceed market value, the investments are written down to market value if management considers that there is a permanent impairment in value.

Fixed assets

The Foundation capitalizes the cost of major capital additions and amortizes the cost of these assets over their estimated useful lives. Lease inducements received in conjunction with the Foundation's lease are offset against the cost of leasehold improvements. Management has determined the estimated useful lives to be:	
Computer and office equipment	5 years straight-line
Office furniture	10 years straight-line
Leasehold improvements - net of lease inducements	straight-line over the term of the lease (10 years)

Interest and dividends

Interest on bonds, mortgages and short-term notes is accrued as earned. Dividends which have been declared are recorded as income on the date of record set for the dividend.

Operating expenses

Administration expenses, program expenses and investment management and custodial fees are recorded using the accrual basis.

Comparative figures

Certain comparative figures have been reclassified to conform with the presentation adopted for 2000.

4 Investments

Consolidated Trust Fund

The bonds and debentures in the Consolidated Trust Fund are represented by Canadian fixed interest bonds and debentures, with a weighted average term to maturity of 9.1 years (1999 - 8.9 years). The effective interest rate on these bonds and debentures is 5.7% (1999 - 7.5%).

The common shares and convertible securities in the Consolidated Trust Fund are represented by the following:

5 Commitments

In addition to the amounts presented under "Funds returns pending distribution", the Foundation has committed to grants totalling \$1,390,000 (1999 - \$1,193,000) which are payable from future returns. Payment of these grants are conditional on the recipients meeting certain criteria and providing certain supporting information.
